- He is Our Ultimate Authority. He is the Most High there is none Higher than Yahuwah³ and He is One and Only One⁴.
- Who we are? We're a Nation that is the Set Apart descendants of Abraham, Isaac and Yakob⁵. We are chosen for his Purpose, and are His Chosen Set Apart People⁶. We are given a choice to obey his Law and we freely choose to obey his Laws as we were commanded to do from days of old7.
- What He requires us to do? He Requires our Allegiance, Obedience, Faith and Trust8.
- d. We are to have No Other Before his Face⁹.
- e. We Are Qadash to be separate, pure 10.
- 2. All Power- Yahuwah has all power over the things in the Heavens and on the Earth¹¹.
- 3. Allegiance and Oaths- We are to have no other mighty one before Yahuwah. (1 d. footnote 9).
- 4. Absolute Law Scripture is the Highest Law. 12 His Word/Law has power and is Straight 13. As we are followers of the Scriptures we invoke All Rights given to us by our Creator and according Scripture.
- 5. Author We are made in his likeness and Image Living Souls¹⁴. He is the Creator of all¹⁵.
- 6. Authority We have the Right to our name in it's proper form. We have Authority to Change our Name(s)¹⁶. We have the Authority to name ourselves. 17 We Have the Authority to have Spiritual name(s) which is superior to any legal name (person) and have exclusive Claim and exclusive use of our Spiritual Name which Our Creator has freely given us¹⁸.
- 7. Apart- We are to be in the world but not a part of the world.

 - a. It is against our Law and Spiritual Belief to Pay Taxes According to Scripture.²⁰
 - **b.** We are not to be Surety²¹ for debts.²²
- 9. Abode We abide in peace under Yahuwah's Rule.²³ We have a right to Religious Land.²⁴
- 10. Acknowledgement We have the right to self-determination.²⁵
 - a. Scriptures clearly states that we are to rule over our own nation, not to vote for a foreigner to rule over us.²⁶
 - **b.** We have the right of freedom²⁷ of travel on the land in the air and on the seas.
- 11. Above Yahuwah Rules over all nations.²⁸
- 12. Aborigine-Pre-Colonizers State of Being as we are called to be set apart from the other nations. We are a Nation unto ourselves.²⁹ Right to Self-governance.³⁰
- 13. A Separate Nation/Tribe- We are a Separate Nation according to Yahuwah³¹ in his Set apart Scriptures.³² We are not to be conformed to the world. We are to be Set apart from the World.³³ We are to follow the Laws of Yahuwah above the Laws of Man³⁴ for the Laws of man are derived from Yahuwah's Laws.

There is a Clear Command for us not to Follow the laws (Statues and Codes, Color of Law)of man. There is a clear Command for us to separate from the nations. ³⁵

- **14. Accord-**As the united States of America are signatories to many Treaties we are holding them to these treaties.
- 15. All Shall give an Account-Everyone will give an account for all that they have done to the almighty Judge.³⁶
- 16. Another Way-We are commanded not to be conformed to this world³⁷ as this world is at enmity against Yahuwah.³⁸
- 17. A Living Temple- Our Bodies are a Living temple and they belong to Yahuwah and we are not to allow anything in them that Yahuwah Has not given approve or made. Anything that goes against the wishes of us is a violation of our spiritual beliefs.

The Scriptures teaches us that we cannot serve Two Masters.³⁹ We can only Serve One and we freely chose to Serve Yahuwah.⁴⁰

Further it instructs us to come out of Her my people. The Her in which the Scriptures speaks of is the Political/Religious/World system which is masquerading as nothing more than a Religious System.⁴¹

Scripture is the Source of all Laws and we Lay out the following as our laws which we hold closely.

LAWS OF SCRIPTURE

A great scholar said, "If a man-made law cannot be traced to a divine source, then not only should its effectiveness be questioned but, even more, its intent should be suspected."

The divine laws, as revealed to Moses, must be discerned spiritually and put into practice in our daily life. Wise decisions, based on obedience to the laws of the Bible so abundant in mercy and justice, bring about the constant harmony and peace, which can be ours.

SECTION IV.

Paragraph I. Laws of a general nature shall have uniform operation throughout the State, and no special law shall be enacted in any case for which provision has been made by an existing general law. No general law affecting private rights, shall be varied in any particular case, by special legislation, except with the free consent, in writing of all persons to be affected thereby; and no person under legal disability to contract, is capable of such consent.

Par. II. Legislative acts in violation of this Constitution, or the Constitution of the United States, are void, and the Judiciary shall so declare them.

- Article 1. All human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights. They are endowed with reason and conscience and should act towards one another in a spirit of brotherhood.

Everyone is entitled to all the rights and freedoms set forth in this Declaration, without distinction of any kind, such as race, colour, sex, language, religion, political or other opinion, national or social origin, property, birth or other status. Furthermore, no distinction shall be made on the basis of the political, jurisdictional or international status of the country or territory to which a person belongs, whether it be independent, trust, non-self-governing or under any other limitation of sovereignty.
- Article 3. Everyone has the right to life, liberty and security of person.
- Article 4. No one shall be held in slavery or servitude; slavery and the slave trade shall be prohibited in all their forms.
- Article 7. All are equal before the law and are entitled without any discrimination to equal protection of the law. All are entitled to equal protection against any discrimination in violation of this Declaration and against any incitement to such discrimination.
- Article 9. No one shall be subjected to arbitrary arrest, detention or exile.
- Article 12. No one shall be subjected to arbitrary interference with his privacy, family, home or correspondence, nor to attacks upon his honour and reputation. Everyone has the right to the protection of the law against such interference or attacks.

Article 13.

- (1) Everyone has the right to freedom of movement and residence within the borders of each state.
- (2) Everyone has the right to leave any country, including his own, and to return to his country.

Article 15.

- (1) Everyone has the right to a nationality.
- (2) No one shall be arbitrarily deprived of his nationality nor denied the right to change his nationality.

Article 16.

- (1) Men and women of full age, without any limitation due to race, nationality or religion, have the right to marry and to found a family. They are entitled to equal rights as to marriage, during marriage and at its dissolution.
- (2) Marriage shall be entered into only with the free and full consent of the intending spouses.
- (3) The family is the natural and fundamental group unit of society and is entitled to protection by society and the State.

ARTICLE 3

The political existence of the state is independent of recognition by the other states. Even before recognition the state has the right to defend its integrity and independence, to provide for its conservation and prosperity, and consequently to organize itself as it sees fit, to legislate upon its interests, administer its services, and to define the jurisdiction and competence of its courts.

The exercise of these rights has no other limitation than the exercise of the rights of other states according to international law.

ARTICLE 6

The recognition of a state merely signifies that the state which recognizes it accepts the personality of the other with all the rights and duties determined by international law. Recognition is unconditional and irrevocable.

ARTICLE 8 No state has the right to intervene in the internal or external affairs of another.

ARTICLE 10

The primary interest of states is the conservation of peace. Differences of any nature which arise between them should be settled by recognized pacific methods.

ARTICLE IX
